Rule 1002 Notice

2004 Federal Legal Holidays^{1/}

PCAOB Rule 1002 governs the computation of periods of time prescribed in or allowed by the Board's rules or orders. Under Rule 1002, federal legal holidays affect the computation of these time periods in certain circumstances. The Note to Rule 1002 provides that the Secretary will maintain a list of federal legal holidays. For 2004, those holidays are:

January 19	Birthday of Martin Luther King, Jr.
February 16	Washington's Birthday
May 31	Memorial Day
July 5	Independence Day
September 6	Labor Day
October 11	Columbus Day
November 11	Veterans Day
November 25	Thanksgiving Day
December 24	Christmas Day
December 31	New Year's Day 2005
